I have testified at numerous regulatory body hearings, including Texas Railroad Commission, Texas Water Quality Board, Texas Land Commission and Federal SEC. In addition, I have qualified and testified in international arbitration hearings. The Firm has operated 800+ wells in Texas, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Louisiana. Currently, the Firm operates approximately 40 Wells in Texas.

In the Victoria area, responsibilities included direct supervision of eight drilling rigs throughout the Texas Gulf Coast and East Texas area. This included supervision of directional drilling and open-hole fishing jobs. The job responsibilities also included supervision of a Unit operation including assisting in the design, purchase and installation of gas compressors which injected gas into a reservoir at 6000 psi. Well depths under my supervision ranged from shallow 1800 foot wells on salt domes to 17,000 foot Wilcox wells. I was responsible for the drilling and completion of LPG storage wells in salt domes and the repair of same. I testified at numerous regulatory body hearings as an expert witness, including one which requested and was granted the first 320 acre oil spacing in the State of Texas.
